



# **President of EFOMP and President of EFOMP Company - introduction**

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# Job description

## Appointment Process

- **Vice President:** Nominated by an NMO and elected by Council
  - **President:** Automatic after one year as Vice President
  - **Past President:** Automatic after three years as President
  - **Company President:** Elected Annually at the Company AGM
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# Job description

## Tenure

- **Vice President:** One year. Not eligible for re-election
  - **President:** Three years. Not eligible for re-election
  - **Past President:** Two Years. Not eligible for re-election
  - **Company President:** Normally the same as for the President. Elected Annually at the Company AGM.
  - **Responsible to:** Council and Company AGM
  - **Accountable to:** Council and Company AGM
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# Job description

## Duties

### - Vice President

- Stand in for the President when the President is not available.
- Assist the President with his/her duties

### - President

- Presides at the Officers' and Council meetings
  - Legal representative of EFOMP
  - Represents EFOMP at European and International conferences and at meetings with European and International collaborating organisations and societies.

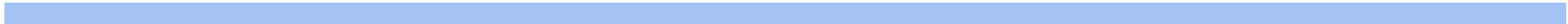
## Duties

### - **Past President**

- Stand in for the President when the President is not available.
- Assist the President with his/her duties
- Provides advice to the EFOMP Officers

### - **Company President**

- Presides at the Company Board and Annual General meetings
- Legal representative of the Company



# EFOMP Company



**EFOMP is a company limited by guarantee and not having a share capital**

The Registered Office of the Company is situated in England (York).

The Company have powers:

- i. To raise funds and invite and receive contributions from any person, firm or Company by way of donation and otherwise.
- ii. To purchase, take on lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire any real or personal property and any rights or privileges which the Company may think necessary or convenient for the promotion of the primary objects, and to construct, maintain and alter any building or erections necessary or convenient for the work of the Company
- iii. To sell, let, mortgage, dispose of or turn to account all or any of the property or assets of the Company as may be thought expedient with a view to the promotion of primary objects.

# EFOMP Company



- iv. To undertake and execute any charitable trusts which may lawfully be undertaken by the Company and may be conducive to the primary objects.
  - v. To borrow or raise money for the purposes of the Company on such terms and on such security as may be thought fit.
  - vi. To invest the monies of the Company not immediately required for its purposes in or upon such investments securities or property as may be thought fit, subject nevertheless to such conditions (if any) and such consents (if any) as may for the time being be imposed or required by law and subject also as hereinafter provided.
  - vii. To establish and support or aid in the establishment and support of any charitable bodies and to subscribe or guarantee money for charitable purposes in any way connected with the primary objects or calculated to further the same.
  - viii. To do all such other things as are necessary to the attainment of the primary objects or any of them.
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# President of the Federation EFOMP

- Belongs to the group of executive officers (ExComm) – president, past-president (vice-president), secretary general and treasurer
  - Primarily takes care of the political part of EFOMP activities
  - He is the representative of EFOMP in international organizations
    - IAEA
    - IOMP
    - ICTP
    - ESR
  - He nominates the EFOMP representatives, after consultation with the Board, in initiatives which are supported by EFOMP.
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# Relationship with IAEA

- On occasion the President of EFOMP is asked by different departments inside the IAEA to provide support to the initiatives organized by the Agency in the field of Medical physics. The support may consist in:
    - Publication of the initiative on the EFOMP website
    - Nomination of EFOMP representatives
    - Submission of application form for participating to IAEA initiatives by European Medical Physicists.
  - The President submit the name/names of the EFOMP representatives, after consultation with the Board.
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# Relationship with IOMP

- EFOMP is one of the regional organizations of IOMP
- EFOMP is entitled to have two delegates in the Council of IOMP (which are usually the President and the Past/Vice President)



# Relationship with European Society of Radiology (ESR)

- Annually the President of EFOMP is asked by ESR to propose during the European Congress of Radiology:
  - An EFOMP workshop
  - A joint session EFOMP-ESR

This is done in consultation with the Chair of the Physics in Radiology Subcommittee of ESR at the European Congress of Radiology (ECR) for the given year.

- ESR also ask the EFOMP President:
  - To propose names for the ESR Physics in Radiology Subcommittee
  - To propose names for the nomination of one member of program planning committee of ECR

# Relationship with European Society of Radiology (ESR)

- The President submit the name/names of the suggested EFOMP representatives, after consultation with the Board. The final decision on the nominations is taken by ESR.
