The selection of members and consultants was based on CVs.

The number of WG members is limited to 10 (minimum 5). Members do the necessary literature study, analysis of data and write the reports, statements, policies of the WG under the direction of the WG chair.

WG members have the highest influence on the process. The funding of the WG is spent on the WG members in the case of life meetings (travel and accommodation).

Consultants have also an active role in the group, but they are not eligible for reimbursement in case the WG is financially supported by EFOMP.

The group will have a remit, approved by Governing Committee and Council, to produce a document which shall include in its title the phrase “EFOMP Policy Statement No. 20”

Before publication in the European Journal of Medical Physics (EJMP) and displayed on the EFOMP website, the Policy Statement must be seen by the NMO`s council delegates and approved by a majority of those NMO`s council delegates who voted (1 month period).
