



## **European Attestation Certificate to those who have reached the MPE status (EACMPE)**

### **Documentation required**

To reach MPE status (Level 8) in the specialty area requires a **minimum** total of four years equivalent clinical training (2 years equivalent of foundation training in the specialty area to clinical certification and a further two years equivalent of advanced, structured experience and CPD in the specialty).

#### **For certified medical physicists:**

- Application
- Curriculum Vitae
- Certificate issued by a national certification body that certifies physicists and related scientists to practice medical physics
- Contact details of the national certification body (postal address, telephone, email address)
- Proof of **at least** two full-time years equivalent of advanced, structured experience and CPD in the specialty.

#### **For non-certified medical physicists:**

- Application
- Curriculum Vitae
- Proof of academic qualifications, e.g. MSc, PhD, etc. (copies of university-awarded degrees)
- Proof of clinical training indicating the duration of medical physics training signed by the training institution.
- Proof of **at least** two full-time years equivalent of advanced, structured experience and CPD in the specialty.
- For candidates with less than two years of clinical training only: proof of experience as a supervised medical physicist is required
- Proof of active membership of the relevant national medical physics society.

Candidates who have trained in more than one sub-discipline must contact the EEB to check their eligibility.

**Submission of complete accompanying documentation must be finalised by the application deadline.**

**All documents not in English must be accompanied by certified translations.**
